Then there is a set of grids which lists the students in the order requested when running the report.

The first three columns do not have anything at the top of them. They are:

1. An ascending numeric number to help identify the students
2. Student ID number
3. Student name – SURNAME, Forename.

Students in both bold and italics are Repeat students. Students that have a line drawn through them have been excluded by Academic Registry and should not be considered by the Board. Students with an asterisk after their name are expected to complete the course in the current academic year.

Then there are a further three columns:

- Reg Yr** The number of years the student has been registered on the course
- St** Student Status (R=Registered, W=Withdrawn, I=Interrupted). If a status of T,C or P appears, please contact the RSSA Team.
- Mode** Mode of Study (F/T=Full time, P/T = Part Time, S/W = Sandwich)
- CAT** Student Category (e.g. R – Repeat etc.)

There is a section headed up **Level 2 & 3 (FHEQ Level 5 & 6)** next with the following columns:

- 1** Count of Level 2 and 3 credits where student has a unit mark of 70 or above
- 2:1** Count of Level 2 and 3 credits where student has a unit mark of 60-68
- 2:2** Count of Level 2 and 3 credits where student has a unit mark of 50-58
- 3** Count of Level 2 and 3 credits where student has a unit mark of 40-48
- F** Count of Level 2 and 3 credits where student has a unit mark of 0-38
- P/F** Count of Level 2 and 3 Pass/Fail credits where the student has a result of 'Pass'
- SA** Count of credits with a decision of Second Attempt Assessment
- D** Count of credits with a decision of Deferred First Attempt
- >50%** The classification in which more than 50% of the Level 2 and 3 credits fall (after discounting the worst 20 credits at Level 2 and 3), ignoring RPL and interest only

Columns 1, 2:1, 2:2, 3 and F will also discount the worst 20 credits from Level 2 & 3 (FHEQ level 5 & 6).

Then there is a column **LX Cr** which lists the number of credits passed at Level X.

Then there are three further columns of **Averages**

- Level 3 Ave** Weighted average of Level 3 (FHEQ Level 6) marks excluding Pass/Fail, RPL and interest only units which also discounts the worst 20 credits
- Level 2 Ave** Weighted average of Level 2 marks excluding Pass/Fail, RPL and interest only units which also discounts the worst 20 credits

40/60 Weighted average of Level 2 and 3 (FHEQ Level 6) marks excluding Pass/Fail, RPL and interest only units weighted at 40% of Level 2 and 60% of Level 3, after discounting the worst 20 credits at each level

Then there is a section **Credits by Level**

- 1** Count of Level 1 credits passed
- 2** Count of Level 2 credits passed
- 3** Count of Level 3 (FHEQ Level 6) credits passed
- Oth** Count of credits passed that are not at Level 1, 2 and 3
- All** Count of credits passed at all levels

Then there are the columns for classification

- L3 Ave** Classification of Level 3 (FHEQ Level 6) average
- L2/3 weighted** Classification of weighted average of Level 2 and 3 marks
- Pre by class** Classification of best 100 credits at Level 2 and 3
- Drd** Displays the best of the three classification methods. If there is no Y in the Rec column, it will show as a Fail
- GPA** The grade point average unit marks in the 40/60 weighted average, discounting the worst 20 credit GPA at each level
- Rec** Y is populated in this column if the system has calculated that the student has met the criteria for an award or if it has been manually overwritten that a student has Recommend the Award as a progression decision
- Decision/Class** A blank column for notes
