Then there is a grid which lists students in the order requested when running the report.

The first three columns do not have anything at the top of them. They are:

1. An ascending numeric number to help identify the students
 2. Student ID number
 3. Student name – SURNAME, Forename.
- Students in both bold and italics are Repeat students. Students that have a line drawn through them have been excluded by Academic Registry and should not be considered by the Board. Students with an asterisk after their name are expected to complete the course in the current academic year.

Then there are a further three columns:

- Reg Yr** The number of years the student has been registered on the course
St Student Status (R=Registered, W=Withdrawn, I=Interrupted). If a status of T,C or P appears, please contact your Faculty Advisor.
Mode Mode of Study (F/T=Full time, P/T = Part Time, S/W = Sandwich)

There is a breakdown of **Credits by Level**

- 1** Count of Level 1 credits passed
2 Count of Level 2 credits passed
3 Count of Level 3 credits passed
M Count of Level M credits passed
Oth Count of credits passed that are not at Level 1, 2 and 3
All Count of credits passed at all levels

Then there is a section showing **Units Not Passed**

- SA** Count of credits with a decision of Second Attempt Assessment
D Count of credits with a decision of Deferred First Attempt

Then there are three further columns of **Averages**

- 2** Weighted average of Level 2 marks, excluding Pass/Fail, APEL and Interest Only units which also discounts the worst 20 credits
3 Weighted average of Level 3 marks, excluding Pass/Fail, APEL and Interest Only units which also discounts the worst 20 credits
M Weighted average of Level M (FHEQ level 7) marks, excluding Pass/Fail, APEL and Interest Only units which also discounts the worst 20 credits

- Level 3 & M Weighted Average** Weighted average of Level 3 and Level M marks excluding Pass/Fail, APEL and Interest Only units and discounting the worst 20 credits from each level

Level 2, 3 & M Weighted Average Weighted average of Level 2, 3 and M marks excluding Pass/Fail, APEL and Interest Only units and discounting the worst 20 credits from each level

Next is the **Qualifications** section

Method 1 The classification of the weighted mean from all relevant credits at Level 3 and level M (FHEQ levels 6 & 7) in the ratio of 50:50 respectively, after first discounting the marks in the worst 20 credits at Level 3 and Level M (FHEQ levels 6 & 7)

Method 2 The classification of the weighted mean from all relevant credits at levels 2, 3 and M (FHEQ levels 5, 6 & 7) in the ratio of 20:40:40 respectively, after first discounting the marks in the worst 20 credits at Levels 2, 3 and M (FHEQ levels 5, 6 & 7)
