RESULTS OF ELECTION OF ACADEMIC STAFF GOVERNOR 2018

Academic Staff Governor

A Staff Governor elected by and from Academic Staff

Elected: Dr David Sanders, Reader in Systems and Knowledge, Faculty of Technology

First term of office: 1 August 2018 – 31 July 2021

Process

Three candidates stood for election.

1,387 Ballot papers were issued.

201 Votes were received: 14.5%

(Papers received in previous years: June 2002: uncontested; June 2004: 180; June 2006: 205; June 2008: 173; June 2010: 182; June 2012: 205; June 2014: 196; June 2016: 247)

Valid papers counted: 200 (1 spoilt ballot paper)

The details of the breakdown of votes at each stage are recorded in the table below. In brief:

- Dr Kevin McSorley was eliminated first with 34 votes;
- Following transfer of votes (11 expressed no next preference), Dr David Sanders achieved the highest number of votes.
